ARTICLE I

(Name of Club) The name of this Club will be the Literature Club.

ARTICLE II

(Purpose of Club)

ARTICLE III

(Authority)

ARTICLE V

(Meetings)

Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life room CC 217.

ARTICLE VI

(Officers)

President – Preside over all meetings. Call special meetings. Vice President – Supports presidents, takes over in their absence. Treasurer – Keeps financial record.

ARTICLE VII

(Elections) Officers shall serve 1 term(s) and will be elected each February/October.

ARTICLE VIII

(Amendments)

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval 70% of the Club members.
